

# Central European Grand Slam

2019 Bratislava, Budapest and Prague

**Day 2:** After **breakfast** at the hotel (included), we embark on our guided **sight-seeing tour of Budapest**. You will be amazed by the sweeping panoramas of hilly **Buda's Hapsburg Palace** and beautiful **Danube River** that splits the city, reunited by the **seven magnificent bridges** that seem to knit the town back together. **Day 3:** After **breakfast** and checkout, we departure for **Prague**, checking into our a 4-star hotel around mid-day. The afternoon will feature a historical city tour of **Prague Castle**, the **Old Town** and **Charles' Bridge**, and will end with a traditional **Czech dinner** (included). Transportation will be available for those wanting to return to the hotel following dinner, or if you prefer, stay out and experience Prague's world-class nightlife.

**Day 4:** After **breakfast** at the hotel (included), the morning offers **free time** to continue your exploration of Prague to shop, see the sights or enjoy a meal before our early-afternoon departure. Transfer from hotel to Prague Center provided by RTT.
