WINTER HIKING

Groomed winter hiking trails from the Eisgrat mountain station to the Gamsgarten mountain station (300 m altitude, 45 minutes of walking) and from the Gamsgarten mountain station to the Bödelehütte hut (little difference in altitude, no more than 2 hours for the return journey).

ICE GROTTO STUBAI GLACIER

Immerse yourself in the world of eternal ice around the Eisgrat mountain station. A 200-meter circular path teaches you interesting facts about glacial phenomena.

STUBAI ICE CLIMBING TOWER

20-meter-tall ice climbing tower, open from December to March. Courses for beginners on request. Stubai Alpin mountain guide office: Tel. 0043 5226 34 61.

CROSS-COUNTRY SKIING

2 km cross-country trail at Gamsgarten.

TOP OF TYROL SUMMIT PLATFORM 3.210 m

Spectacular views of more than 109 three-thousand meter peaks from the summit platform. TOP OF TYROL is open all year round, provided that snow conditions are favorable. It is a wonderful destination for a day trip.

SCHAUFELJOCH CHAPLES

Just a few minutes' walk from the Schaufeljoch mountain station, the Schaufeljoch chapel is a peaceful spot to pause and take in the stunning natural beauty of the Stubai Glacier.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

RISKS IN THE HIGH MOUNTAINS

The fascinating beauty of the high mountains does not come without danger: be aware of glacier crevasses, avalanches, snowstorms, sudden fog and intense sun.



- ++ If you decide to venture outside of the signposted, opened slopes, you will be on unsecured, open terrain and fully responsible for your own safety.
- ++ You will be in a glacial area in the High Alps, where there is a risk of avalanches. Do not leave the signposted slopes without the right equipment and good knowledge of the dangers involved.
- ++ Before attempting an off-piste run, obtain information about the current risk of avalanches.
- ++ Runs must be closed when there is a danger of an avalanche occurring. In the event of an emergency, please follow the instructions of the mountain rescue service or the cable car staff. If you personally find yourself in an emergency situation, dial the SOS emergency phone number 0043 5226 8141 160.
- ++ Observe the barriers. Take note of warning signs (danger of avalanches and glacial crevasses) and the orange warning light near the panorama panels.

RESCUE SERVICE

If you witness a sporting accident, please provide first aid. Secure the site of the accident and inform the rescue service.

GROOMING OF SLOPES

All opened slopes on the Stubai Glacier are groomed every night. When it snows, they are groomed again in the morning. In case slopes need to be groomed during opening hours, there is a risk of collision between skiers and the snow groomers. Therefore they are only permitted to operate in the daytime if it is strictly necessary. Additional grooming runs do not fall into this category. Observe the groomers' warning light and horn and keep a safe distance. In fresh snow, moguls inevitably appear over the course of the day. We thank you for your understanding.

SKI RUNS

Signposted, monitored, groomed and safe.

SKI ROUTES

Signposted and protected against avalanches but neither groomed nor monitored. For current information about open slopes and facilities, see the panorama panel and stubaier-gletscher.com

NATURAL SNOW

Due to the high proportion of natural snow, the slopes may change somewhat over the course of the day. It's a small price to pay: skiing on natural snow is a lot more fun.

WINCH GROOMING

In these areas, the slopes are groomed using the winch-grooming technique. The rope dragging the groomer up crosses the slope. Please be aware of all barriers.

The slopes are closed from 4:30 pm to 8 am every day. During those hours, no protection measures are in place! There is a risk of injury from grooming equipment and the grooming process: snow groomers, snow cannons, ruts, winch ropes, uncovered cables and the tubes of the snowmaking system.

SNOWMAKING

Be aware of the snow-making system and the snow cannons across the entire area. Around the snow cannon, visibility may be lower and the snow quality may be different.
